2010 Pennsylvania State Championship Western Section

Date: August 6, 7 & 8, 2010

Location: 211 Staff Road, Slippery Rock, PA 16057. Approximately 10 miles north of Butler, PA.

Sponsored By: MORaine CONSERVATION AND SPORTSMENS ASSOCIATION

Eligibility: Competitors must be a current member of the Pennsylvania Rifle & Pistol Association or their home state association. Applications for the PRPA will be available.

Classes & Categories: NRA system will be used. If fewer than four (4) entries in a class, competitors will be moved to their respective categories in the next higher class. Reserve participants, National Guard members and full time police officers, will fire in the SERVICE CLASS.

Rules: All current NRA Conventional pistol rules will be in effect for this match.

Classification: The NRA Classification system will be used in all matches. Individuals who have not been classified, will fire in the MASTER class. Rule 19.6 (Assigned Classification) and Temporary Scorebooks may also be used.

Facilities: The Range is equipped with 15 electronically controlled targets. The firing lined is covered.

Squadding: Squadding will be on a first come first serve basis, with preference given to shooters who intend to shoot the complete 2700. The 2700 point aggregate will be fired in one day. There will be a relay on August 6, 2010 (minimum of 6 shooters required) a relay on August 7, 2010 and one relay on August 8, 2010.

Advanced Entries: **Advance entries are requested.** We expect each relay to be full. Therefore your advance registration will assure the competitor of his/her preference and help to make the registration smoother. You will be notified if your preferred relay is filled.

Challenges: A \$1.00 challenge fee will be charged. See NRA Rule 16.1 for procedures to be used.

Match Conditions: Scoring will be done down range. Competitors will be responsible for repairing their targets. Competitors and Scorers will sign all scorecards. **Only range personnel are authorized to use scoring plugs. All cell phones and pagers must be turned off on the firing line.**

CMP Excellence in Competition Match: There will be an EIC "Leg" match relay following the 2700 Relay on Saturday August 7, 2010 and Sunday August 8, 2010. Course of fire will be the CMP Service Pistol Match. This match will be conducted in accordance with the current Civilian Marksmanship Program Competition Rules. Advance registration is requested so that we may squad all shooters. Preference will be given to Non-Distinguished shooters.

Distinguished Revolver Match: Only individuals who are eligible for NRA Pistol Competition pursuant to Section 2 of the NRA Pistol Rules shall be eligible to compete in this program. One Distinguished Revolver Match will be conducted. There will be a relay each day. This match will be conducted per NRA Rules Section 23 and the Equipment; Ammunition etc will be governed by NRA Rule 3.1.4. Advanced Entries are requested. Course of Fire will be the National Match Course.

Post Entries: Will be accepted up to the range capacity.

Awards: Awards will be Cash. There will be an OPEN winner, in addition to class awards in each match. The OPEN winner is not eligible for class awards. Classes will be combined upward if there are less than four (4) competitors in each class. If there are fewer than four (4) High Masters (and Masters if combined) they will compete for the OPEN award only. There must be at least 4 competitors in a class to qualify for an award, with an additional award for each additional 4 shooters.

Entries Close: Individual match entries will close on the day of the match.
