2014 PENNSYLVANIA STATE INDOOR PISTOL CHAMPIONSHIP

The PRPA Indoor Championship Match was fired on April, 5 & 6 2014. The tournament was hosted by the Somerset Sportsmen's Club, in the Western Section of the state, and the Eastern Section tournament was be held at the Harrisburg Hunter's and Angler's Club Inc. The Guthsville Rod and Gun Club had been the club hosting the Eastern Section for several years. It was decided by the club to stop hosting the tournament and the Harrisburg Hunter's and Angler's Club stepped up and agreed to host the Indoor Championship for 2014. We are very happy to include them and as they have hosted the fall 1800 tournament for several years, we expect a great tournament as has been the usual result from them.

There were 56 shooters that were in competition at Harrisburg and 8 competitors at Somerset. These shooters were from the states of Pennsylvania, Maryland, Virginia and New York. After the smoke cleared, Steve Gibbons from Lewistown, PA, was the State Champion with a score of 2616 and 123x's. Finishing second was Matt Buckman from Lovettsville, Va with a score of 2609-85x. Third was Ron Steinbrecher from Wyndmoor, PA with a score of 2600-100x. All three of these shooters are classified High Master!

In the master Classification the high shooter with a score of 2585-91x, was Daniel Kupar from White hall, Pa. Second place was Jerry Ford from Lewistown, PA with 2549-74x. Third place was Paul Styner with as score of 2540-73x. Paul is from Yardley, PA.

In the Expert Class the High Shooter was Tim Burris from Mifflintown, Pa. Tim posted a score of 2542-66x. Following Tim in second place was Ron Siliani, from Clifton Heights, PA. Ron fired 2501-62x. finishing in third place was Tony Brong from Harrrisburg, PA with a score of 2476-73x.

In the Sharpshooter Class first place was Jake Wilt from Salisbury, Pa. Jake fired 2382-35x for top honors. Finishing second was Joe McDaniel from Grantsville, MD. Joe's score was 2361-41x. Third place was Gabe Julian from Honeybrook, Pa. Gabe is a Grand Senior(70 years old plus) and he fired a score of 2357-36x.

In the Marksman Classification top score was posted by David Lawton from Glen Mills, PA. Dave fired 2343-43x. In second place was Jenna Tomarelli. Jenna ended the day by winning the Junior and Women's PA State Championship! Jenna fired a score of 2296-40x. Third place was Mike Brygider from Stroudsburg, PA. Mike posted 2212-31x.

Congratulations to Steve Gibbons the 2014 State Indoor Champion and Jenna Tomarelli the State Indoor Women and Junior Champion! There were 4 Grand Senior shooters that fired the match and 3 Women that were in competition for the 2 day match! Congratulations to all and we hope to see you all again somewhere on the line!!

JUNIOR HIGH POWER RIFLE CLINIC

The Pennsylvania Rifle and Pistol Association will be holding a Junior high power rifle clinic on Saturday May 17th at Reade Range near Fallen Timber PA. Directions to the range can be found at the Reade Range web site: www.readerange.org. The clinic teaches the rules and techniques of competing with a national match service rifle (AR-15). High power service rifle competition is fired from the standing, sitting and prone positions at 200, 300 and 600 yards with rapid and slow fire stages.

The clinic is open to all experience levels. We will teach safety, rules, the course of fire, the use of equipment, the three different shooting positions.

The clinic will begin at 9:00 a.m. Please show up at the range by no later than 8:30 a.m. We will break for lunch at noon. Please bring a lunch and refreshments. Lunch will not be provided. The clinic will finish at the 600 yard firing line at approximately 3:00 pm

There is some equipment available, such as: rifles, shooting coats, shooting mats, spotting scopes etc., if needed. We will be shooting approximately 80 shots. Shooting a .223 service rifle at 600 yards requires specialized match ammo such as 77 grain Federal Gold Medal Match or 77 grain Black Hills match. If possible, please bring enough ammo for the clinic. A limited amount of Federal Match ammo is available if needed. Other equipment that is highly recommended: hearing and eye protection, long pants, sweatshirt, hiking/work boots, rain gear, baseball hat, etc. Please contact me with any questions about appropriate apparel and equipment. Also, please contact me ahead of time about any equipment you need to borrow so I can make arrangements.



PA Junior Intermediate Smallbore Rifle Camp

June 18—22, 2014

The Pennsylvania Rifle and Pistol Association and a grant from Friends of the NRA will support the state wide, 3 position summer camp program. This camp is intended for intermediate level junior shooters, who have shooting experience and would like to grow as a marksman. The facilities of Indiana University of Pennsylvania will be used for housing and dining and the indoor rifle range is located at the Indiana County Fairgrounds. The camp capacity is 20 junior shooters, ages 13 to 17 and will be held June 18 - 22, 2014. All shooting is with .22 cal. target rifles, on a 50' indoor rifle range. A variety of shooting exercises and events make up the program. The SCATT system is used to analyze the natural point of aim of a shooter so proper alterations to positions can be made. The goal of this camp is to expand and advance the shooting levels of the junior shooters attending. We encourage junior shooters who are interested it participating and competing in higher levels of competition to attend. In addition to the coaching from our volunteer staff, juniors have the opportunity to meet others with similar interests and abilities.

Camp registration fee is \$200. The fee, along with an NRA Foundation Grant and support from the Penna. Rifle & Pistol Association, provides the campers with dormitory rooms, meals, transportation on campus, and related marksmanship materials. All applications will be reviewed and 20 shooters will be selected. Final deadline for submission of applications is March 15, 2014. We have instituted a change in the State Service Pistol Championship for 2014 and have included two (2) additional championships into the program. These additional championships are a .22 caliber Iron Sight Championship match and Service Revolver Championship match. The .22 can be fired with any type of NRA rule legal .22 pistol using only Iron Sights, and the Revolver segment will use the NRA Distinguished Revolver rules. The Service Pistol, as always, will be governed by CMP rules, but the format has been changed as follows: this format is that the competitors will fire a 40 round match, 2 targets of Slow Fire; a Timed Fire target; and, a Rapid Fire target. The competitor will fire a "Leg" Match consisting of 1 Slow Fire Target, 1 Timed Fire Target and 1 Rapid Fire target. The scores of all 70 rounds will combined to award the Championship.

We also have changed the dates for the tournaments to October 4 & 5, 2014. 
