

PA ATTORNEY GENERAL ATTACKING SELF-DEFENSE & RECIPROCITY

Our PA Attorney General, Kathleen Kane, holds the 'right to carry a firearm' for self-defense in low regard. She ran for office on a gun control platform (see it here: http://www.pagunrights.com/2012/11/kathleen-kane-gets-anti-gun-support/). Her conduct demonstrates an ideologue mentality regarding firearm ownership by her policies in limiting, modifying and/or outright eliminating reciprocity & recognition agreements with other states. These policies have greatly impacted not only residents of PA but also non-residents from a growing number of states.

There is now a solution to this problem – <u>HB 2398</u> intoduced by state Rep. Rick Saccone which is currently in the PA House of Representatives Judiciary Committee. This legislation will close the bureaucratic loophole that the Attorney General is using to modify these interstate agreements. So far she has modified or cancelled agreements with 5 states - Florida, Arizona, Virginia, Idaho and Utah.

We need your help in reaching out to PA House members to solicit their support, co-sponsorship and direct intervention in seeing this legislation moved out of committee and to the floor of the House for a full vote!

We are asking YOU to go to the USRKBA Action Center and take a moment to send an email (through the site below) Pro-Gun PA State House Representative urging him/her to rein in this rogue Attorney General. Completing this action will send your message to EVERY Pro-Gun House member in the PA Legislature.

Please help us with this effort to see this legislation is pushed through the Judiciary Committee and to the House floor for a vote and then to the Senate for a vote and passed. For an elected state official, AG Kathleen Kane, to so brazenly toy with the right of citizens to defend themselves and their loved ones is a betrayal of the public trust.

2014 PRPA PISTOL TEAMS AT THE NATIONAL MATCHES

This year the PRPA sponsored 4 teams in the NRA Team Championships and the CMP Service Pistol Team Championship. The teams consisted of Steve Gibbons from Lewistown, Jerry Ford (also from Lewistown), Joe Urish from Butler, Tom Mix from Ebensburg, and Brian Keyser from Birdsboro. This team was in competition in the Master Class and was denoted PRPA Gold.

The second team also was competing in the Master Class due to the classification of the members. This team was PRPA Silver. The members were Jeff Lloyd from Cresson, Brian Dean from Butler, Tim Burris from Mifflintown, and Patrick Kelly from Lewistown.

The third team was PRPA Bronze and was competing in the Expert Classification. The members were Gerald Green from Greenville, Duane Lewis, also from Greenville, Dennis Kriek from Glenshaw, Roger Carfangia from Slippery Rock, and Eric Verhasselt from Hatfield. Eric just moved to Pennsylvania from New Jersey and we are very happy to have him in our neck of the woods!

The fourth team was in competition in the Sharpshooter Class and was the PRPA Blue. The members were Mike Brygider from Stroudsburg, Eric Wheary from Schwenksville, Tom Fewer from Harleysville, Adam Higbee from Greenville, and Eugene Martin from Johnstown.

The first day of competition was fired with .22 pistols. The Blue team finished in 7th place out of 9 teams, with a score of 1028-15x. The Bronze Team finished in 14th place out of 31 teams with a 1092-20x. The Silver Team finished with a score of 1102-25x and placed 5th out of 6 teams. The Gold team fired a score of 1128-33x for Second place in the Master Class.

Day two was fired with Centerfire Pistols and the teams finished the day as follows. The Blue team scored 1005-14x, and finished in Second place for the day. The Bronze team fired 1066-14x for 11th place. The Silver team scored 1071-26x and was in 5th place again. The Gold team ended the day with a win with a score of 1108-40x for First place.

The third and final day of team competition was fired with .45 cal pistols. The Blue team made its' come back and finished the day with a score of 1015-17x for second place. The Bronze team fired 1005-15x to finish the day in 23rd place. The Silver team fired a score of 1082-24x to finish in 4th place. The Gold team ended the day with a score of 1108-24x. The Gold team had been competing in the Master Class for the 2 previous day but since both High Master shooter fired on the .45 day they were moved into the High Master Classification for that day. None the less, they ended up in second place in the High Master Class for the day!

The only thing left was to see where the teams were finally placed after all the scores were totaled. In the Sharpshooter Class, the Blue team finished in 3rd place! Great come back from the first day! The Expert Class in this competition was the largest group. The State Association was grouped with the Expert Law Enforcement teams. The Bronze team finished the team competition in 19th place. The Silver Team ended the team matches in 6th place. But the high point of the team competitions was our Gold team winning the Master Class overall! Great job Gold Team and all the teams! They all really knew we were there!

On Sunday the CMP Service Pistols were the order of the day. The day started out with overcast and some rain. In the afternoon, the PRPA Service Pistol Team was called to the line. The members of our Service Pistol Team were Brian Keyser, Steve Gibbons, Patrick Kelly Jr., Tony Brong, Brian Dean, and the "New" Shooter, Tim Burris. The Service Pistol Team finished with a score of 1023-17x to finish in 4th place of 11 teams.

The teams met for a Team Dinner on Thursday after the firing was done for the day. The dinner was held at McCarthy's Pub in Port Clinton. This is something new for us as we had not done this in the past. The shooters seemed to be greatly in favor of keeping this practice for the future. We all had a good meal and a good time at the dinner. Really the only time we get all the teams together is at the team meeting and picture day so this gets the team members all together, with no "shooting" agenda. The get together was a good time for all of us and we will be doing it as a general practice from now on.

Great showing for our guys and we are very proud to sponsor this great group of competitors! We look forward to bigger and better things from them in 2015! As always, we need some new shooters to get started and we had a couple this year in Adam Higbee, and Eric Verhasselt. Glad to have you guys on board!

The Outdoor State Championships were fired on the last weekend of July at the Wilkes-Barre Rifle & Pistol Club in the Eastern Section and in the Western Section the Moraine Sportsmen's club fired on the first weekend of August. At the time this is being written the scores are still being processed and the report will be in the next Newsletter.

There is a new Championship match coming up on October 4 & 5. This will be something that we have not done in the past. There will be a .22 Iron Sight Championship Match, a Service Revolver Championship Match (using the NRA Distinguished Revolver Rules) and a Service Pistol Championship. The Service Pistol will be fired in a 40 round (President's 100 type) Match and then a 30 round CMP (Leg) match and the 2 scores will be combined and a Champion will be named in each segment of the match. The Host Clubs will be the Leni-Lenape Pistol Club in Boyertown, Pa (Eastern Section) and the South Fork Rifle Club in Sidman, PA (Western Section). We hope this will be a successful match for both clubs and for the Association.

NRA GRANT HELPS 86 YOUTH LEARN FIREARM SAFETY

For the past 44 years, the Pennsylvania State American Legion and the Pennsylvania State Police have partnered together to conduct a week-long camp for 17- and 18-year old boys and girls who are looking to a career in law enforcement or the military. 97 youth came from all over the Commonwealth to attend this summer's camp held June 10-11, 2014 at York College of Pennsylvania.

Pennsylvania has over 800 American Legion Posts scattered across the state with 240,000 military veterans belonging to the Pennsylvania American Legion. The American Legion provides a wide range of community service and youth programs with American Legion-State Police Youth



Week being unique to Pennsylvania.

The camp includes firearm safety training and a shooting clinic program developed by NRA-certified

Legionnaires from North Harrisburg Post 1001. Post 1001 is affiliated with the Pennsylvania Rifle & Pistol Association, the National Rifle Association, the Civilian Marksmanship Program, and USA Shooting. The program utilizes an old warhorse familiar to many veterans, the .30 US Carbine. Led by Fred Rogers, Harrisburg Hunters' & Anglers' Association High Power Director and NRA-certified Instructor/Range Officer, the club provided their M1 carbines as well as a number of their NRA-certified Range Safety Officers and NRA-certified Rifle

Instructors. HHA acquired the carbines from the CMP for youth marksmanship and safety training. Through the courtesy of FOP President, Matt Emig,

> the live fire exercise was conducted at the York County Fraternal Order of Police Range.

The NRA Foundation funded the ammunition necessary for the firearm safety training given to the youth attending the 2014 SPYW. Without the NRA grant, the training could not have taken place.
