A Brief Overview of The Bill of Rights and the Freedoms They Guarantee

There are 10 fundamental and basic guarantees in our Bill of Rights that are essential to a free democracy - rights that many perilously take for granted.

Every Amendment in the Bill of Rights specifically guarantees citizens' protection from government. It is our safety net against government intrusion and control of our lives; it is our guarantee of Freedom and Liberty.

Many of us forget what each of those first 10 Amendments to our Constitution, called The Bill of Rights, really do guarantee. To put them in terms that are easy for all to understand, we can condense them into the following:

1. The (1st) First Amendment guarantees freedom of religion, freedom of speech; freedom of press; freedom to peaceably assemble; and freedom to petition government for redress of grievances.
2. The (3rd) Third Amendment prohibits the military from commandeering your home for its own quarters.
3. The (4th) Fourth Amendment protects you against unreasonable searches and seizures and against warrants issued without probable cause - it protects your right to privacy.
4. The (5th) Fifth Amendment guarantees protection against self-incrimination - but further it protects you against being deprived of life, liberty or property without due process and prevents government from taking your property without just compensation.
5. The (6th) Sixth Amendment guarantees a speedy and public trial by an impartial jury of your peers; the right to face your accusers; the right to know the specific charges against you; and the right to be represented by counsel.
6. The (7th) Seventh Amendment guarantees the right to a jury trial and protection against what is commonly called double jeopardy.
7. The (8th) Eighth Amendment guarantees against excessive bail and cruel and unusual punishment.
8. The (9th) Ninth Amendment guarantees that rights under the Constitution shall not be used to deny other rights retained by the People.
9. The (10th) Tenth Amendment guarantees that the Federal Government has no powers other than those specifically granted in the Constitution and reserves all other powers to the states and to the People.
10. And finally, the Amendment I saved for last because I believe it is the most important - **THE (2nd) SECOND AMENDMENT**. It guarantees the individual the **right to keep and bear arms**.

Why is the Second Amendment the most important? Because our Founding Fathers knew that without firearms, the People could not protect themselves against foreign or domestic tyranny. They knew that without firearms the People would have no way to preserve the Freedom and Liberty guaranteed by our Constitution and Bill of Rights.

So, the Second Amendment is about more than just guns - **It's about freedom**. It is a right **without which we Americans could never have fought the Revolutionary War, won our Freedom and formed an independent nation** - a right without which government can take away all of your Freedoms. Don't be fooled, government cannot take total control of the People as long as the Second Amendment is intact and peaceful, average, hardworking citizens can freely own firearms.

CONVENTIONAL PRONE COMPETITION INSTRUCTIONAL SCHOOL

The Seitzland Rifle Club, located at New Freedom, Pa., announces that they will again host a summer Smallbore Prone School. Dates are June 24-27, 2008. This is a four day school that provides detailed instruction and considerable range firing exercises for both beginner and advanced conventional prone competitors. The emphasis is on wind/mirage reading, competition prone match procedures, and a thorough review of prone position shooting fundamentals. At the conclusion of the school, a two day Conventional Prone Regional Match will be held. This weekend match provides a timely opportunity for prone school students to test their newly acquired skills and knowledge in elbow-to-elbow match competition against some of the best Smallbore shooters in the USA.

In past years, in addition to the numerous beginning and junior competitors who received training, there have been a number of very experienced prone competitors in attendance. This wide cross-section of experience translates to considerable exchange of knowledge and assists all who attend in becoming improved competition shooters. Many Junior shooters have found this school to be an outstanding beginning to the sport of both competitive and recreational prone shooting.

The cost of the school is \$100. The Seitzland Club has submitted a request for an NRA Foundation Grant to help defray cost, and if approved, ammunition may be provided. Students are responsible for their own transportation, housing, and meals during the school. George Harris, veteran smallbore rifle competitor, NRA Rifle coach, and recently retired from the NRA, is the chief instructor. 2008 marks the 15th year that George has conducted this type of instruction.

In 1759, Benjamin Franklin cautioned, "They that can give up essential liberty to obtain a little temporary safety deserve neither liberty nor safety." Gun control is not about safety, and it's not about crime.

When politicians tell you that government "needs" to ban certain firearms because nobody "needs" to own or possess one, or because government "needs" to ban them for public safety reasons, you are losing your Freedom. Remember the warning of William Pitt, in a speech to the House of Commons in 1783, "Necessity is the plea for every **infringement of human freedom**. It is the argument of tyrants, it is the creed of slaves."

If you don't care that they ban your friend's semi-automatic firearm because they label it an "assault weapon," or your brother's small handgun because they label it a "Saturday Night Special" or your neighbor's inexpensive handgun because they label it a "junk gun," you have been lulled into complacency. Make no mistake, your shotgun or hunting rifle - however expensive or high quality - will be termed "offensive" and surely be next on the ban list.

If the Second Amendment can't stop government from deciding what gun your neighbor can own, it certainly can't protect the firearm you choose to own.

More than 200 years ago our Founding Fathers understood that these fundamental rights could never be entrusted to government. That's why our Founders guaranteed them to all the People through the Bill of Rights. Today it is our duty to protect these rights or our heritage and our Freedoms will be lost forever.
